Meeting Notes

Subcommittee Chairman Talbot called the meeting to order at 1:00 PM.

Roll was called by District Executive Director Anthony Duplechin and a quorum was established. All subcommittee members were present.

Minutes from July 18, 2019 meeting were approved with one typo amendment. (Walton/Morvant)

Anthony Duplechin, District Executive Director and Roy Waggenspack of Owen & White, Inc. gave an update on the status of the test well:

Mr. Duplechin stated that the drilling of the well was complete, and the rig had moved off-site and the drilling contractor (Griner Drilling) is in the process of reclaiming the site. The recent rains have made a somewhat of a mess at the site.

Mr. Waggenspack added that our landman was working with the landowner, Mr. Nguyen, and that the surveyor will survey the site and have the property corners and well-pad servitude corners established (with iron property markers) so that the 10'X10' slab can be poured. In addition, he will need to produce a property map showing this and it needs to be recorded with the Clerk of Court.

A grab sample was taken and showed a chloride level of 235 mg/L. This reading was not unlike what Baton Rouge Water Company found at the Progress Park site when they were sampling in advance of their 1,500-foot sand scavenger well. The water in the well must be allowed to reach an equilibrium to get a valid sample.

It was discussed that the well be given three months before discrete sampling is undertaken (the first week of February 2020). Five samples taken at even intervals over the eighty feet of sand will be taken at \$2,000 apiece (\$10,000) No motion was made as it had been decided that the

District Executive Director had already been given discretion to handle this.

Mr. Waggenspack anticipates that Griner will finish cleaning up the site, get the slab poured and the fence erected and file for final payment less the cost of sampling and analysis.

Mr. Duplechin and Mr. Waggenspack will meet with the landman and landowner to ensure that the site is acceptable, and with the driller to coordinate collection of the discrete samples.

Selection of the second well site will occur after the sample results are reviewed.

Subcommittee members had no additional comments, nor did the public.

It was moved by Walton and seconded by Morvant to adjourn the meeting at 1:19 PM.
